



**Marriage Act 1949
Mission and Pastoral Measure 2011**

IN EXERCISE of the powers contained in Section 23 of the Marriage Act 1949 and Paragraph 12 of Schedule 3 of the Mission and Pastoral Measure 2011 **DONALD, BISHOP OF PETERBOROUGH**, hereby direct in relation to persons entitled under the provisions of the Marriage Act 1949 or under the provisions of the Church of England Marriage Measure 2008, as amended by the Church of England Marriage (Amendment) Measure 2012, to be married after the publication of bans of matrimony in one of the parish churches of the United Benefice of **LONG BUCKBY WITH WATFORD AND WEST HADDON WITH WINWICK** that the bans of matrimony may be called and the marriage solemnised in any parish church of the said Benefice **PROVIDED** that:

- (a) nothing in this order shall deprive a person of the right to be married in any church in which he or she would have been entitled to be married if this direction had not been made
- (b) a person may be married in a church in which he or she would have been entitled to be married as aforesaid notwithstanding that the bans of marriage have, by virtue of this direction, been published only in some other church
